Policy:

Fraser Coastal International College provides admission for students in TESOL areas. However, where appropriate, access to programs and courses will be restricted to students who satisfy established admission criteria at both general and program-specific levels. Students have been refunded for fee they have paid if they satisfy criteria mentioned in this policy.

Principles

Fraser Coastal International College insures that all refunds are completed by authorised designated person, based on refund requirements.

Related fees include: administrative fees, application fees, assessment fees, and fees charged for textbooks or other course materials.

Fraser Coastal International College may retain up to 10% of tuition, to a maximum of \$1,000. Fraser Coastal International College must refund fees paid for course materials if not provided to the student.

<p>After program start date, Fraser Coastal International College provides a notice of dismissal or receives a notice of withdrawal (applies to all students, except those enrolled in a program delivered solely by distance education)</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After the program start date, and up to and including 10% of instruction hours have been provided. 	<p>Fraser Coastal International College may retain up to 30% of tuition.</p> <p>Fraser Coastal International College must refund fees paid for course materials if not provided to the student.</p>

<p>After the program start date, student withdraws or is dismissed (applies to students enrolled in a program delivered solely by distance education):</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student completed up to 30% of the program. 	<p>Fraser Coastal International College may retain up to 30% of the tuition. Fraser Coastal International College must refund fees paid for course materials if not provided to the student.</p>

Fraser Coastal International College must refund fees paid for course materials if not provided to the student.</p>

<p>Fraser Coastal International College does not provide a work experience</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Fraser Coastal International College fails to provide the work experience within 30 days of the contract end date, unless the registrar determines the Fraser Coastal International College was prevented from doing so by circumstances beyond its control. 	<p>100% tuition and all related fees, other than application fees</p>

Fraser Coastal International College must pay the tuition or fee refund **within 30 days** after receiving notice of withdrawal or refusal of study permit; providing a notice of dismissal, or the date on which the first 30% of the hours of instruction are provided (no-show).

If an international student delivers a copy of a refusal of a study permit to Fraser Coastal International College, sections 1(a), 1(b), 4, 7 and 8 of this policy apply as if the copy of the refusal were a notice of withdrawal, unless:

- a. the international student requests an additional letter of acceptance for the same program that was the subject of the refusal of a study permit,
- b. or the Certificate in TESOL Program is provided solely through distance education.
